

# "The Love of God Will NEVER Let Us Go"

Romans 8:38-39

Paul uses 5 statements to answer the question in verse 35.....  
God's Word teaches us that, as God's people, no one or nothing  
can separate us from the love of Christ.

Notice these 5 truths:

I. Not the \_\_\_\_\_ of death nor the \_\_\_\_\_ of life can..... v38  
"death, nor life"

Now the Apostle Paul wasn't afraid to die, for he wrote in **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:55**  
***O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?***

Then he wrote in **Philippians 1:21** ***For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.***

Key thought: For believers death doesn't take us \_\_\_\_\_ from Jesus it  
takes us \_\_\_\_\_ His presence. **2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 5:8**

II. Not the \_\_\_\_\_ of angels nor the \_\_\_\_\_ of demons can..... v38  
"nor angels, nor principalities"

Paul is saying "neither angels nor the forces of hell can break....." **HALLELUJAH**

III. Not the \_\_\_\_\_ of today nor the \_\_\_\_\_ of tomorrow can..... v38  
"nor things present, nor things to come"

Yesterday, today and tomorrow can never separate us from Jesus' love,  
you know why, because **Hebrews 13:8** says.....

IV. Not the \_\_\_\_\_ of Heaven nor the \_\_\_\_\_ of hell can..... v39  
"nor height, nor depth"

not anything so \_\_\_\_\_ and not anything so \_\_\_\_\_ can.....  
neither time nor space can.....

**Psalm 139** says "There's nowhere we can go beyond God's love."

V. Not anything \_\_\_\_\_ v38 "power"  
not anything \_\_\_\_\_ v39 "nor any other creature" can.....

Now while these verses are not saying we're not going to have suffering and sorrow  
in this life as God's people, what these verses are saying, is while \_\_\_\_\_  
may \_\_\_\_\_ us in this life they will never separate us.....

Key thought: \_\_\_\_\_ was never the promise, \_\_\_\_\_ was !!! **TYJ**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Cor. 2:14** ***Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ.....***

**Thank God, Jesus' love will NEVER LET US GO !!**
