And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,"

"Do not worry about tomorrow" (Matthew 6:34)

(2 Corinthians 12:9)

"My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

King James Version of verse 25 ("As thy days, so shall thy strength be"),

Alexander Maclaren wrote, "The two sums of 'thy days' and 'thy strength' keep growing side by side, the one as fast as the other, and no faster."
