v12 "I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want."

Five "situations" which every believer can be victorious through Christ.

A. In verse 4: "Rejoice in the Lord always..."

The key word is "rejoice"

which occurs in varying forms no less than \_\_\_\_\_ times.

B. In verse 5: "Let your gentleness be evident to all..."

D. In verse 6: "In everything, by prayer..."

E. In verses 8-9: "Think about such things..."

YOU CAN CONQUER IN CONTEMPLATION THROUGH CHRIST!
